I shall get back about the first of September. Brother Froom is to take my place at the Advanced Bible School. I suppose you have heard of the death of Professor Kern's son-in-law, Lyndon Skinner, which occurred Monday or Tuesday night while he was at a hotel in Denver, Colo. The funeral is this afternoon. We are greatly pained to lose this young man who was a promising worker. . Elder Daniells is still here. I think he plans to leave today or tomorrow. We hope that packing up and returning home will not be too hard on you. We invite you to our home when you arrive. It will afford us pleasure to have you with us.
